Introduction

- Introduce yourself: State your name and the scholarship you are applying for.
- Opening Sentence: An engaging opening sentence to attract the committee members (quote, question, or statistic).
- Details: Why you want this scholarship.
- Connection: An experience that relates to your academic or career goals.

Body Paragraph 1: Personal Background

- Opening Sentence: A hook sentence that changes your life.

Body Paragraph 2: Academic Achievements

- Opening Sentence: Highlight what you have achieved in your educational career.

- Connection: connect your achievements to the purpose or values of scholarship.

Body Paragraph 3: Leadership and Community Impact

- Opening Sentence: Discuss a leadership role or community service you had previously.
- Details: Explain your contributions to that role and what you have achieved.
- Connection: Show how these experiences display your commitment to making a difference.

Conclusion

- Restate the main points: retell the reader your qualifications and goals in one or two sentences.
- Tell the need: Explain how this scholarship will help you in achieving your academic goal.

Call to Action: Reaffirm your commitment to the field of study or career path supported by the scholarship.
